### 1. Summary

This report provides an update on activity since the July Strategic Planning Group. The latest OHSEL newsletter is attached for information.

### 2. Programme Highlight reports

PMO highlight reports for July 2018 are attached

The STP End of Year reports have also now been produced and detail progress made over the 2017/18 financial year.

Key areas to note on the clinical and productivity programmes (by exception) are:

- **Pathology network** - the procurement for a new pathology provider across SE London was launched in August.
- **Cancer and Mental Health** - bids have been submitted to Health Education England to support workforce planning to help address the predicted future shortfall of specialist staff in these areas.
- **Orthopaedics Network** - the orthopaedics network has now agreed the optimal pathway for hip and knee replacement across SE London. The network board meets for the first time this month.
- **Community Based Care** - we are refreshing the strategy for community based care (CBC). This includes the development of a new prevention Clinical Leadership Group (CLG) which will look at the wider determinants of health and also coordinate the many prevention workstreams taking place across our STP

programmes. It will also include a focus on community providers as well as continuing with work on primary care development.

### **3. Areas of Development and Focus**

The focus of the STP continues to be on how we can make services sustainable for the people of South East London, delivering high quality patient care with the best possible outcomes in ways that are affordable

Key areas of development at the moment are reflected in the agenda for the meeting but include:

- Preparing to make a bid for a wave 3 Integrated Care system by taking part in the aspirant programme (see item 7)
- Responding to the 'call for evidence' for the NHS Long Term plan and supporting wider engagement activity (see item 8)
