Summary: This paper provides an update on activities related to the NHS Long Term Plan, and seeks endorsement by the Board of the final response document and proposed next steps.

1. Background

In November 2019 the OHSEL Board received and agreed the second draft of the south east London integrated care system (SE London ICS) response to the NHS Long Term Plan. At that time it was explained that the original (national) intention had been that the second draft would be the final document, but in following general election guidance local systems were unable to sign off their responses in public. The finalisation of Long Term Plan responses was therefore postponed until early 2020.

The SE London ICS is now in a position to finalise its response to the Long Term Plan. With the exception of the finance chapter (see section 2 below) there have been no substantial changes made between the second and final versions of the response, though minor amends have been made throughout to update the content that was written at the end of October 2019. Additionally small updates have been made in response to a further round of stakeholder engagement, including to reflect comments received from:



- Colleagues working within the OHSEL clinical leadership groups and enabling workstreams.
- The Clinical Programme Board.
- The Patient and Public Advisory Group.
- Public CCG Governing Body meetings, where a particular focus was the draft content on the respective borough's local partnership working and priorities.

2. Finance

The finance chapter is in the process of being refreshed to reflect the latest commitments and agreed assumptions that seek to deliver the SE London financial improvement trajectories over the strategic planning period. This content will be reported to the OHSEL Board and shared more widely when available.

3. Proposed next steps

Subject to endorsement of the final Long Term Plan response by the OHSEL Board, the proposed next steps are to:

- a) Continue developing the glossary to accompany the final document, to support lay members in understanding the content of the response.
- b) Continue development of a public facing summary of the Long Term Plan response, testing the draft content with members of the Patient and Public Advisory Group as part of this process.
- c) Hold a co-designed workshop with representatives from voluntary and community organisations to support strengthening relationships between those organisations and the ICS, thereby acting upon feedback received through engagement exercises undertaken in summer 2019.

4. Recommendations

The OHSEL Board is asked to:

- i. **Endorse** the final version of the SE London ICS response to the NHS Long Term Plan (enclosure Fii), noting that the response is a live document and plans will continue to be shaped as they are implemented.
- ii. **Approve** the proposed next steps as described in section 3 above.
